<b>Animation Technique (20 points)</b>	Animation is very smooth and fluid. Character and object motions are brought to life in a realistic way. The technique is excellent and consistent. <b>Story/Concept (20 points)</b>	There is a clear storyline, concept, or idea evident.	The storyline is mostly clear, although some scenes may distract the audience.	The storyline is not present or extremely difficult to understand. The audience does not understand the story at all.
